

North Shuswap School

Grade 8 School Fees for 2022-2023

As per school district policy, North Shuswap Elementary School will be collecting the following school fees this year.

- **School Purchased Supplies** **\$35.00**
This is a **mandatory** fee for each student. The *school purchases student supplies* in bulk so parents do not have to purchase them. This ensures quality, uniformity, variety and need is met for all students throughout the year.
- **Student Agenda** **\$10.00**
This is a **mandatory** fee for each student. Our Agenda Books are used as part of our regular classroom routines in terms of personal organization and responsibility, and as a tool for communication between home and school.
- **Cultural Performances** **\$10.00**
This is an **optional** fee that allows North Shuswap Elementary to provide cultural performances for our students (ie. theatre and musical performances, guest speakers, etc.)
- **Locker Rental Fee (Lock Provided)** **\$5.00**
This is a **mandatory** fee for each student wishing to use a locker.

Total Fees Due (Please pay by September 23, 2022) **\$60.00**

Optional vs. Mandatory Fees

Provincial legislation requires schools make the Student Activity Fees and the Cultural Performance Fees optional, however, our ability to offer these types of programs/activities depends on the money generated by the fees collected. Both our PAC and staff feel the programs supported by these fees are extremely important for our students.

Our school does not charge for an optional Activity Fee at the start of each year as some schools do. We do charge for optional class field trips or activities throughout the year as they are required.

Financial Hardship
